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

To you it is given to dispense the now-filled-up measure of the wrath of God; not a trickling nor a splashing, not in half doses or one-third applications, but an emptying out of the fullness of the wrath of God upon the earth. I Will Not Leave You **Fatherless**

The breakdown of fatherhood always

results in the breakdown of society.

t was the eve of Christ's passion-His betrayal, His trial, and His shameful crucifixion. Gathered with Him to share His last supper were the twelve men closest to Him on earth-called, chosen, gifted men whom He had worked with closely and mentored personally over the past three years. They had traveled the dusty roads together, faced the thronging crowds of humanity together, and suffered the merciless criticism of the Pharisees together. They had shared things that only they could share. And now He was

leaving them. As they sensed the pending separation, a feeling

of desolation must have gripped their sorrowing hearts. No words could adequately frame the loss they were experiencing. They were losing not only a friend, a mentor, and a guide, but the One who had given a sense of direction

and identity to the work they were giving their lives for. They were losing a Father.

Jesus spent the evening preparing them for His departure. He impressed upon them the responsibility He was leaving on their shoulders, and He prayed for them that they might be inseparable in unity. But perhaps the most beautiful promise Jesus left with them that evening was the promise that He would not leave them to fend for themselves: "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Com-

> forter, that he may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit

of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you" (John 14:16-18).

According to Strong's definition, the original Greek word translated comfortless in verse 18, is the word orphanos, meaning "of uncertain affinity; bereaved ("orphan"), i.e. parentless: comfortless, fatherless" (Strong's G3737).

Jesus would not leave His people fatherless. Through means of the pouring out of the Holy Spirit on men, the place of a father would be filled.

The identity of humanity is more intertwined with its fathers than is often realized. Scripture tells us, "And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul" (Genesis 2:7). God formed each one of us with care and precision, but He only formed one man from the dust of the ground. Everyone since then-Eve included-sprang from Adam. (See message on "Fathers" by J. Strizu, Oklahoma City, Nov. 24, 2021). Both physically and spiritually, whether we like it or not, we are the product of a father. Our identity is found in our father.

There are fathers at every level of society. Scripture references Jubal the father of music and Jabal the father of tents and husbandry (Genesis 4:20-21). There are likewise fathers of communities, fathers of tribes, and fathers of cultures. From the apostle Paul, we learn that God has set fathers in the church: "For though ye have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet have ye not many fathers: for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel" (1 Corinthians 4:15). None of us is self-made, nor can we have a meaningful identity outside the people who made us. The breakdown of fatherhood always results in the breakdown of society.

Satan has launched a tireless campaign to disconnect society from its fathers. Attacking fatherhood at all levels, he has corrupted men, demoralized men, taken fathers out of their place, and turned children against their fathers. He has smeared masculinity with labels of danger and toxicity. He has torn down role models of manliness and has confused the roles of men and women in society and in the home.

Through the spread of the Protestant mind frame, he has robbed people of their recognition of the hierarchy God ordained in the church and ultimately of the hierarchy in the family. People grow up believing they are better off making their own choices outside their parents' guidance and don't understand why they end up with trouble and failing relationships. It is because you don't know how to have relationships with your peers until you have a relationship with a true father.

Probably never has history seen a more fatherless generation-and hence a more lost generation-than that we are seeing today. The violence, the unrest, the high suicide rates, the mistrust, the lack of natural affection-so many problems can be traced to a lack of true fathers in people's lives. If the promise that we would not be left fatherless applied only to the dawn of the Gospel Day, it would have left out the ones who most needed it.

But the prophecy does not leave us out. "Behold." declared Malachi. "I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord: And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers. lest I come and smite the earth with a curse" (Malachi 4:5-6).

race and peace from the apostles of the Lord Jesus, who has regenerated us into His own image, that we might be called the sons of God. Truly heaven must be unending, because eternity will not suffice to praise the One who suffered for our sins. An unequal trade it is, that the Only-begotten should be offered for billions of sinners, though every one of them should be redeemed. Praises to God for His mercy!

Perilous times have come, as predicted by the beloved Apostle Paul. False science and false religion, which are the same, have overthrown reason. The foundations of society are swiftly being eroded from under our feet. Humans cannot bear their own probation much longer. They have flung themselves into the abvss of Protestant Relativism, and their self-destruction is irreversible.

Piercing this veil of darkness is the apostolic message of the seventh trumpet. It comes with hope, but also with heaven-shaking power. It offends many who claim to love the cause of Christ. We have not saved ourselves. There is no other name in heaven whereby men may be saved. There is a name exalted above heaven and earth, before which we worship, in this life and the next. There is not a single tenet of doctrine that magnifies Jesus Christ as the supreme, only begotten Son of God, with which we disagree. We bow our knees with all Christians to the Eternal King and Messiah. He is worthy; we are not. Amen.

At no time has our teaching contradicted this sacredly held belief. However, we are forward to acknowledge our manner of speaking has been full of hard sayings, some hard to be understood. We offer no consolation to the unstable ones who wrest our words, but we appeal to those who seek to understand in a spirit of sincerity.

Observe the manner of the Master in John 6:52-59:

> The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us his flesh to eat?

> Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.

> Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.

For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.

He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.

As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.


This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

"These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum." John knew that Jesus knew where He was and whom He was speaking to. He knew the words He uttered were particularly offensive. He intentionally said it to arrest attention. He wanted them to narrow their eyes and ask Him what He meant. He wanted some mad and others curious, so His words could penetrate the thick air of religion that had made the hearts of the people fat.

It is unnecessary to point out that Jesus was being metaphorical; even the Rabbis knew that. Those who listened with their hearts understood that underneath Christ's hard words was a well of truth, even if they couldn't see far into it. Those that sought a reason to hate the gospel were handed one, delivered to their own front door. How direct and offensive were Jesus' words! Never did He go back and soften it so people could "understand."

So how does that apply to us? We are surrounded by an atmosphere of spiritual stupor. The Bible is read in nearly every church-house, and its meaning can hardly penetrate the hearts of the most religious. In fact, it's more likely to germinate in the heart of the irreligious. The spiritual air is heavy with the blanket of religion. Millions hear preaching and never get saved. The gospel is powerless in people's



lives because the religion sold them cannot connect them to the throne of the God-man. They are taught to praise Jesus, yet deny the ambassadors He has sent them. They exalt the deity of Jesus but deny his humanity. They want the

Jesus of heaven, but not the Jesus of earth; seeking Him, only to deny Him when he comes.

Whatever is said by God's preachers is filtered through this air of confusion. A diluted and dead

spirit catches the spoken word and changes it before it even enters the ear of the hearer. The epistles of Paul are read through a veil, and his true meaning is rarely understood. Now, if we are to surrender to the pleas of the offended, we may well offend fewer with our words. We will also save fewer with them. If we say only things which are acceptable to the status quo, we shall offend no one and awaken no one.

> the cross. The offence of the gospel has not ceased. We are bound by God to preach it thus, lest the gospel of Christ be of none effect. We would desire to preach it more softly, but we have been compelled.

We have laid bare our own hearts, subject to the reprimand and disapproval of those we seek to save. We seek the society of fellow men and would be popular and loved by all. But we would rather be reviled than betray

> the commission set before us as apostles. There is no time for us to be too careful about how the insincere will interpret our words. Those that will listen with their hearts will

know that we preach not ourselves, but Christ and Him crucified. And to those that seek an occasion to blaspheme, we say, that except you shall eat our flesh and drink our blood, you shall have no life in you. 🗾

WE FAINT NOT

"Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not." 2 Corinthians 4:1

"We faint not." This is one of the effects of being entrusted with such a ministry. The word here used (ekkakoumen) means, properly, to turn out a coward; to lose one's courage; then to be faint-hearted, to faint, to despond, in view of trial, difficulty, etc. - Robinson.

Here it means, that by the mercy of God he was not disheartened by the difficulties which he met; his faith and zeal did not flag; he was enabled to be faithful, and laborious, and his courage always kept up, and his mind was filled with cheerfulness. He was deterred by no difficulties; embarrassed by no opposition; driven from his purpose by no persecution, and his strength did not fail under any trials. The consciousness of being entrusted with such a ministry animated him, and the mercy and grace of God sustained him.

"Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, WITH THEM that call on the Lord out of a pure heart." 2 Timothy 2:22.

While we grow in grace and in the knowledge of the truth, it is imperative to our soul's spiritual and eternal prosperity that we recognize the utter necessity of wholesome relationships. Paul told Timothy that if we will follow a life that will end in eternal life, it will be WITH THEM that do the same, that have the same vision, burden, understanding, and convictions as we do.

Many Christians have fallen for Satan's trap of isolation and self-preservation, thinking they could maintain holiness and spirituality without the right people. But isolation is not God's plan, for He wants His people to be connected with those that are in the family of holiness and spirituality.

While God can certainly keep a soul holy when there are no other saints in sight, once that soul finds the people of God, at that point, saving faith is maintained at the joints of that holy bond (Ephesians 4:16).

Another fallacy that blinds souls who want to serve God aright is the thought, "I want to win my lost friends and family; therefore, I must constantly be around them." But if a saint is out-numbered by the ungodly, what will usually happen is not that saint influencing their lost aquaintances, but vice versa. Paul declares in 1 Corinthians 15:33, "Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners."

By this, of course, we do not mean that a

saint ought to completely sever every relationship from those who are not saints. The apostle Paul said that we would have to make our exit out of the world itself to do that (I Corinthians 5:10). We love our families and desire to maintain contact with them unless they become antagonistic or will not cease to work to undermine our faith. We must have connections with the lost if we are to win their souls, having an honest enough spirit to discern whether you or they control the atmosphere of your relationship. What we are simply warning against is being aware of where the spiritual safety line is.

Every creature needs the right habitat to survive. If our "new creature" experience (2 Corinthians 5:17) is to live and not die, it will do so because of the right environment. Just as surely as a fish needs water to survive, so saints need one another to maintain their sainthood.

The road to heaven is a road walked by others who are going there too. Simply put, you will not get there alone. It is a wonderful thing to have the blood of Christ wash your sins away. Christ's blood flows through His BODY, the church, and a body has many members, not just one (I Corinthians 12:12-20).

Guard your heart from individuals who you know do not share your same principles. Love, care, and pray for them, but sandbag your life from their worldly influences, while simultaneously clinging to those who walk in the same gospel light that God has revealed to you.

ARMAGEDDON NEWS

Sin is the driving force of the beastly systems of this world, but if there were a close second force, it would certainly be politics. In political systems, the people are pawns. Only the causes matter. And those few courageous souls who try to focus on the people are targets for the fiercest of the enemy's assaults. In this edition of the news, we focus on a few stories that highlight this frontline of the battle. How goes it there?

A Momentous Leak

The United States Supreme Court appears ready to strike down its original 1973 decision in Roe V. Wade, which legalized abortion in the country. In an unprecedented move, someone working at the Court has leaked to the news media a full draft majority opinion written by conservative Justice Samuel Alito. And while a draft opinion is not final, and justices could change their votes during the draft circulation, it signals a major and earth-shattering shift in the direction of the Court.

The leak is the first instance of its kind in the Court's history. While leaks of internal deliberations have happened in the past, no draft opinion has even been seen by the public before the final opinion has been released. Within minutes of the leak being released by Politico, a barrier fence was erected around the Court building and the protests began.

If the basis of the draft becomes final,

and the majority maintain their original vote, abortion will cease to be a Constitutional right in the United States, and it will be up to the individual States to determine their policies on the issue going forward.


